

CARES ACT FUNDING





Department of Education

- \$153.75 million (0.5 percent) set aside for schools and programs funded through the Bureau of Indian in the Department of Education's Education Stabilization Fund
- \$1.04 billion (7.5 percent) for Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) and Minority-Servicing Institutions (MSIs), including Tribal Colleges and Universities (TCUs) in the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund.


Bureau of Indian Education

\$69 million for Bureau of Indian Education Operations

- \$43 million for K-12 school in the BIE system; and
- \$23 million for Tribal Colleges and Universities.

COVID-19 NATIVE EDUCATION PRIORITIES





SCHOOL OPERATIONS

\$1.5 billion in direct funding to Bureau-funded schools, as defined in 25 U.S.C. §2021(3) to meet the health, safety, and educational needs of students due to the impacts of COVID-19.

SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE

\$1 billion in emergency funding to address the backlog of unfunded repairs and renovations at Bureau-funded schools, as defined in 25 U.S.C. §2021(3).

BIE REOPENING PLAN



- Ensure schools close in accordance with tribal, local, and state guidelines
- Provide clear and consistent communication to all schools.
- Expand guidance and professional development on distance education and hybrid education models.
- Ensure high-quality trauma training and mental health services.
- Provide high-quality guidance to support education services for all students, including students with disabilities.
