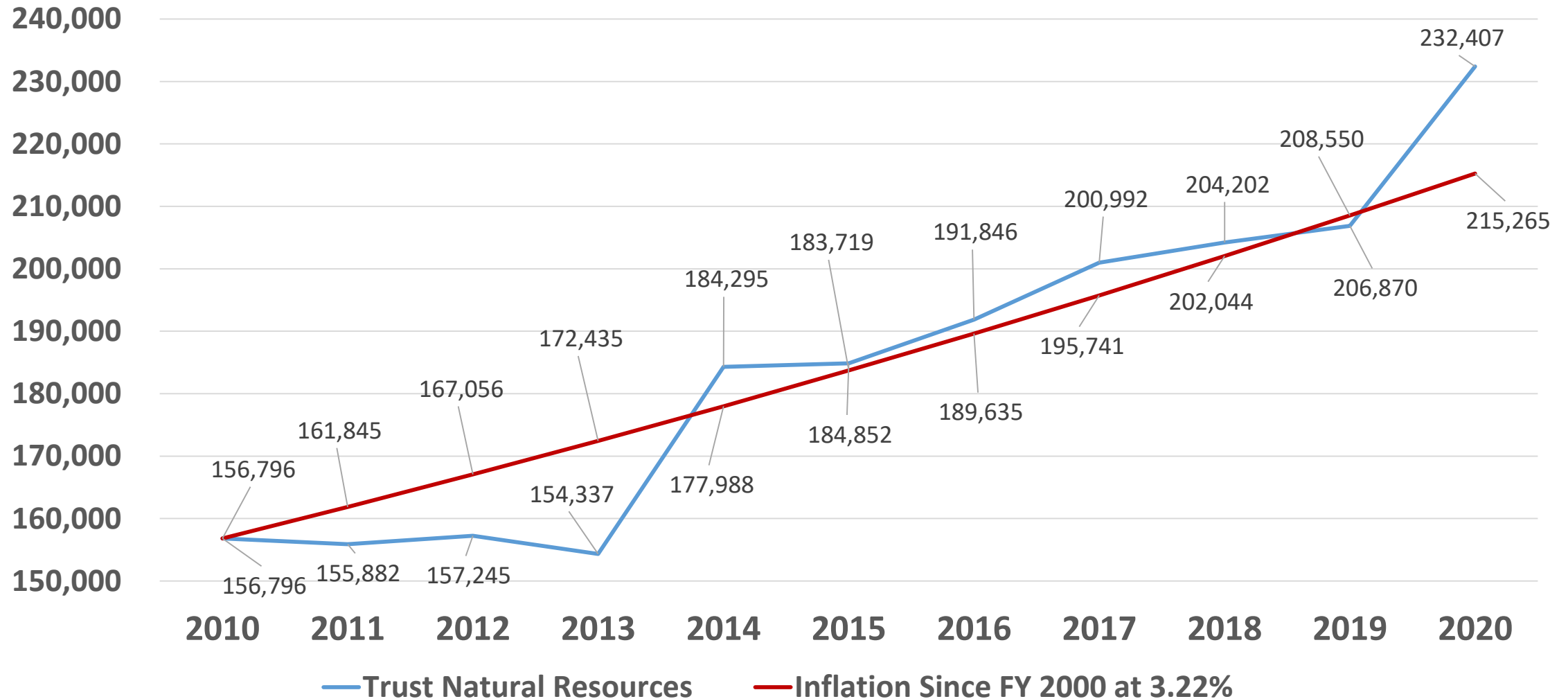

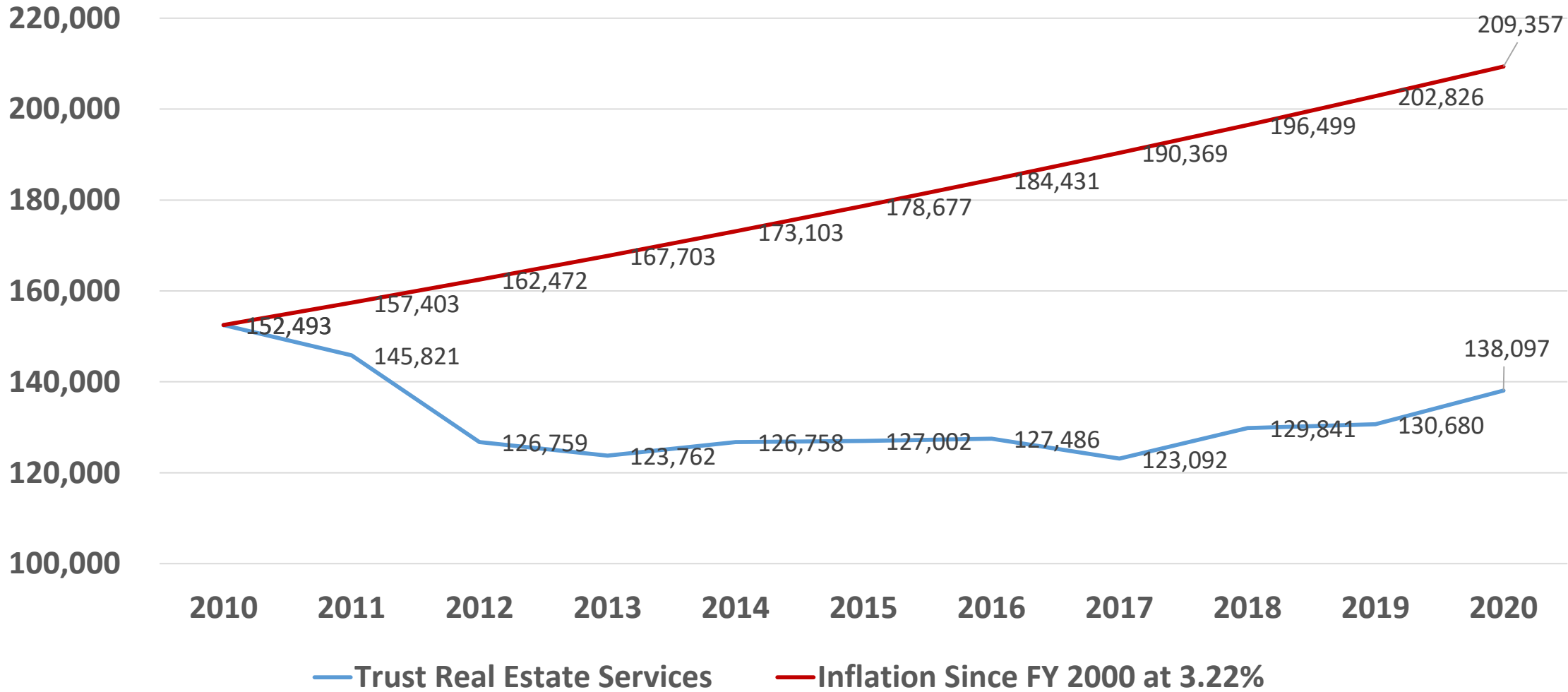

House Report Language for FY 2021 Appropriations

- *Minerals and Mining to Trust-Natural Resources Management.* — The Committee rejects the transfer of Minerals and Mining program to Trust-Natural Resources Management.
- *Indian Youth Service Corps at BIA.* — Section 9003 of the John D. Dingell, Jr. Conservation, Management, and Recreation Act of 2019 (Dingell Act) includes provisions of the 21st Century Conservation Service Corps Act. The Dingell Act established the Indian Youth Service Corps to provide opportunities to expand Tribal youth engagement and service on public land. The recommendation includes \$4,000,000 to establish and implement an Indian Youth Service Corps program at BIA.

House Report Language for FY 2021 Appropriations

- *Historical Funding Analysis for Native Food Activities.* — The Committee expects Indian Affairs to examine the historical funding provided for buffalo preservation and management in comparison to other Native food activities, such as the preservation and management of fish. In fiscal year 2020, the Committee directed Indian Affairs compare historical funding provided to Native food preservation and management activities and a plan to ensure parity among Native food activities to the Committee within 90 days of enactment of that Act. The Committee has not received this information and directs Indian Affairs to provide this information within 90 days of enactment of this Act.
- *Climate Change.* — the Committee directs BIA to coordinate with all relevant Federal agencies—including but not limited to the Federal Emergency Management Agency, the Army Corps of Engineers, the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, and the Departments of Housing and Urban Development, Health and Human Services, and Agriculture—to leverage resources to support a whole of government approach to working with at-risk tribes to identify and expedite the delivery of resources and technical assistance necessary to support mitigation and relocation efforts.
