The Department of the Interior and Department of Health and Human Services are hosting a consultation to identify contract support costs (CSC) long-term solutions. This session follows a series of meetings with tribes that began after the Fiscal Year 2014 Consolidated Appropriations Act’s requirement to consult with tribes to consider a standardized approach that streamlines contract negotiation processes, provides consistent and clear cost categories, and ensures efficient and timely cost documentation for the agencies and tribes. The Office of the Assistant Secretary – Indian Affairs is consulting on a proposed rule regarding trust acquisitions in Alaska. A *Federal Register* notice of May 1, 2014 (79 FR 24648) proposes a rule to delete a provision in the Department’s land-into-trust regulations, which excludes from the scope of the regulations, with one exception, land acquisitions in trust in the State of Alaska.
