

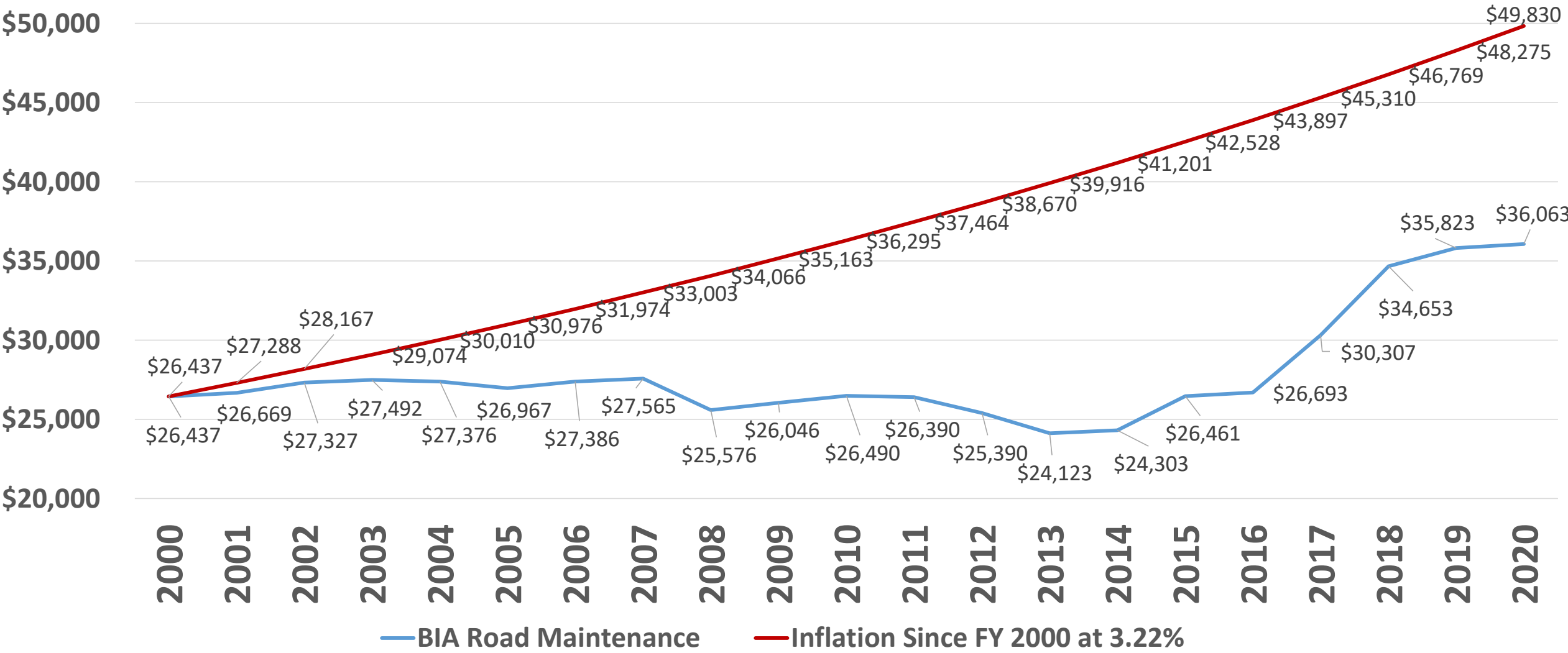

# House Report Language for FY 2021 Appropriations

- *Transportation Funding Analysis.* — The Committee is concerned about reports from some Tribes that their transportation funding has been dramatically reduced since 2004 following the shift to a statutory Tribal transportation funding distribution formula from the “relative need” distribution formula produced in a Tribal-negotiated rulemaking process. The Committee directs BIA to report, within 90 days of enactment of this Act, on how formula funding levels have changed over the course of the past 16 years, Tribe by Tribe, State by State, and region by region so the Committee can compare how the statutory formula has changed Tribal distributions from the relative needs distribution formula (as published in Vol. 69, No. 137 of the July 19, 2004 Federal Register at page 43090).
